



## League of Women Voters of Greater Tucson Endowment Fund

Supporters and friends of the League of Women Voters of Greater Tucson (LWVGT) may help it strengthen its financial future by contributing to its **Endowment Fund**. The fund was established to support its educational and informational programs and projects. The LWVGT hopes to grow the corpus of the endowment fund and thereby increase the annual income that will be distributed.

Below are several ways you can help.

- ***Direct current tax deductible donations to the LWVGT Endowment Fund.*** Contributions of any amount may be sent to the Jewish Community Foundation of Southern Arizona, 5546 E. 4<sup>th</sup> St., Suite 100, Tucson, AZ 85711 for deposit to the endowment fund. Unless a donor wishes to remain anonymous, the LWVGT will be notified when a gift is received. The Foundation will provide the required IRS substantiation letter as well acknowledgement letters for contributions made as tributes (in memory of, in honor of, in appreciation of, etc.)
- ***Remember the LWVGT in your will or trust.*** The language used may be as simple as: "name" wishes to direct XX% or \$XX of her estate to the League of Women Voters of Greater Tucson Endowment Fund held at the Jewish Community Foundation of Southern Arizona.
- ***Establish a named endowment fund.*** Working in collaboration with your attorney and professional advisors, the Jewish Community Foundation can establish a separate endowment fund which you may name (The Smith Family Endowment Fund, for example). The LWVGT may be named as the only charitable beneficiary or you may decide to make it one of several recipients. These plans are extremely flexible and remain confidential unless you choose to advise the LWVGT of your testamentary plans. Endowments are usually funded at the time a person passes away, but may be funded during a donor's lifetime.
- ***Contact the Jewish Community Foundation for more information.*** The LWVGT performed a vigorous due diligence process and selected the Jewish Community Foundation of Southern Arizona to manage its endowment fund. The Foundation has the expertise and resources to assist individual donors with their philanthropic goals.
