Voter Education Presentation: State Ballot Propositions - Pro and Con

After many court challenges and appeals on the challenge decisions, two final voter propositions have made their way to the 2016 Arizona State Election Ballot ... the Fair Wages and Healthy Families Act (Prop. 206) and the Marijuana Legalization Initiative (Prop.205). Again this election year, the League of Women Voters of Arizona has carefully reviewd the legalese of the propositions, researched their pros and cons and published the 2016 LWVAZ Voter Guide ... written in way that can be understood without a law degree.
